## **Statement of Understanding and Code of Conduct**

Statement of Understanding: Troop 376 Youth participants as required and their parents or guardians are asked to read and sign the Code of Conduct and Statement of Understanding as a condition of participation. Ultimately, we want each participant to be responsible for his or her own behavior.

- 1. The Scout Oath and Law will be my guide throughout membership in BSA Troop 376
- 2. While attending scheduled programs and activities, I am required to cooperate with other unit members and leaders as required.
- 3. In consideration of other unit participants, I agree to follow the bedtime and sleep schedule of the unit, unless otherwise directed by the troop program.
- 4. <u>Serious and/or repetitive behavior violations</u> by youth, including use of tobacco, cheating, stealing, dishonesty, swearing, fighting, and cursing, may result in expulsion from the troop or serious disciplinary action and loss of privileges. The *committee chair must be contacted* for the expulsion procedure to be invoked. *There are no exceptions.*
- 5. I understand that possession of lasers of any type, and possession or detonation of fireworks is prohibited.
- 6. I will demonstrate respect for troop property and be personally responsible for any loss, breakage, or vandalism of property as a result of my actions.
- 7. <u>Bullying / Hazing has no place in Scouting</u>. Leaders and older youth must prevent any youth from being hazed or bullied.
- 8. Serious violation of this code may result in expulsion from the troop at the participant's own expense.
